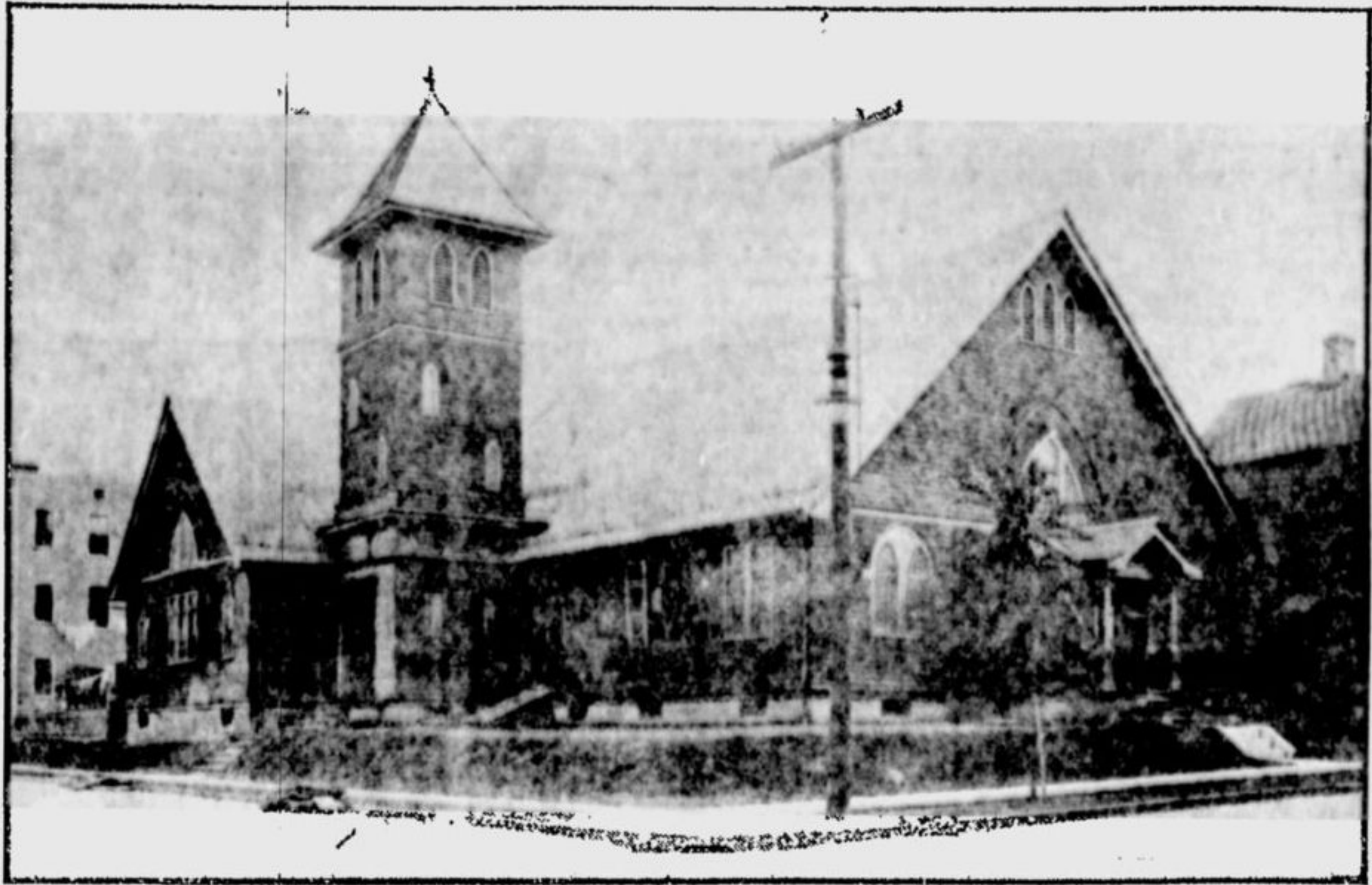


THE NEW WEST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH.



The pretty house of worship which has been built for the West Presbyterian Church at Littleton and Eleventh avenues is now completed and a service will be held in it to-day. It will be dedicated on Wednesday, September 25. There will be a fellowship service there on the next night, and a reunion meeting on the 27th.

As the church is a daughter of the Roseville Avenue Presbyterian Church, the Rev. Dr. William Y. Chapman, pastor of the latter, has been asked to preach the dedication sermon. It is expected the Rev. Dr. John R. Fisher, who was pastor of the West Church several years, will arrive home from Europe in time to

take part in the service on September 25. The present pastor, the Rev. Harold C. Harmon, will preside.
