## OPENING SONG:

Good morning, Roseville. Today we enter Holy Week. The crowds shouted. Branches waved. Hosannas filled the air. But Jesus wept. The uprising is not noise. It is discernment. You can celebrate and still miss the moment. You can shout and still misunderstand what God is doing. Palm Sunday confronts us with a question: Do we recognize the kind of peace Christ brings? Because if you miss the moment—you miss the movement. Let us worship with eyes open.
