Good morning, Roseville. Today is Pentecost — the day the Holy Spirit came like wind, like fire, like a holy interruption. The disciples were not given a gentle breeze they could manage. They were swept up by the movement of God.

And that matters for us. The Spirit does not come just to keep things the same. The Spirit comes to wake us up, give us power, open our mouths, and move the church into God’s future.

Today we also install officers for active service as deacons and ruling elders. This is not just church business. This is Spirit work. The same Spirit who filled the church at Pentecost still gives gifts for leadership, service, care, courage, and witness. So

today we gather around this word: **Not Back, But Beyond.**

Not simply back to what we remember.

Not simply back to what feels familiar.

Not simply back to the way things used to be.

But beyond — into deeper faith, wider welcome, stronger witness, and a future shaped by the Spirit of God.

Let us worship the God whose Spirit still blows where it wills.

SCRIPTURE READING:

Acts 1:6-8 (NRSV)

⁶So when they had come together, they asked him, “Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?” ⁷He replied, “It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Acts 2:1-11 (NRSV)

¹When the day of **Pentecost** (*PEN-tuh-cost*) had come, they were all together in one place. ²And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. ³Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. ⁴All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. ⁵Now there were **devout** (*duh-VOWT*) Jews from every people under heaven living in **Jerusalem** (*juh-ROO-suh-lem*). ⁶And at this sound the crowd gathered and was **bewildered** (*bih-WIL-derd*), because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. ⁷Amazed and astonished, they asked, “Are not all these who are speaking **Galileans** (*gal-uh-LEE-uhns*)?” ⁸And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? ⁹**Parthians** (*PAR-thee-uhns*), **Medes**

(*meeds*), **Elamites** (*EE-luh-mites*), and residents of **Mesopotamia** (*mess-uh-puh-TAY-mee-uh*), **Judea** (*joo-DEE-uh*) and **Cappadocia** (*kap-uh-DOH-shuh*), **Pontus** (*PON-tuhs*) and Asia, ¹⁰**Phrygia** (*FRIJ-ee-uh*) and **Pamphylia** (*pam-FIL-ee-uh*), Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to **Cyrene** (*sigh-REE-nee*), and visitors from Rome, both Jews and **proselytes** (*PRAH-suh-lites*), ¹¹**Cretans** (*KREE-tuhns*) and Arabs — in our own languages we hear them speaking about God’s deeds of power.”
