But those who wait on the Lord renew strength. This is not hype—this is resilience. We are **still rising**. Let us worship the God who strengthens movements beyond moments.

Though we may grow weary, the Lord renews our strength. Let us lift our voices in gratitude to the God who keeps us rising.
